What did you not enjoy about the story? What is a bog baby? What does the bog baby look like? Would you like to find a bog baby?	Listening and understanding and story mapping: Reread the story 'The Bog Baby' again. Now have a go at story mapping the book. Go through each page of the story and write/draw something to represent that part of the story. An example is shown below. What happens at the beginning of the story? What happens in the middle of the story? What happens at the end of the story?	Listening and understanding and writing: Design your own bog baby. You could use playdough, clay, paint or draw a picture. What does it look like? What is special about your bog baby? What would you call it? What is their favourite food? How many toes does it have? Now we want you to write a sentence about your bog baby. Remember to include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. For example, 'He can jump high' or 'She has long wings'.
