Let's get talking!

Your superhero challenge at home is to play some games with your family to develop your Speech, Language and Communication skills. Once you have completed your challenges tick them off and design your own superhero in the frame!

- 1. Share a story with your family: read the book together and put on a play! Can you become the characters and act out the story? Or put on a puppet show!
- 2. Talk about your day! Take time to tell your family all about your day by asking each other this question: Can you tell me three good things that happened today?
- 3. Play the true or false game! Ask your family to solve the puzzles, are they true or false. For example: 'Sheep lay eggs.' 'Christmas is in November.' 'Lobsters are blue in the wild.' Can you think of your own?
- 4. Play the instruction game! Give each other instructions to follow, e.g. 'hop, jump, turn around and touch your toes.'
