






## Key Vocabulary:

Banquet	A fancy meal that took place in castles.

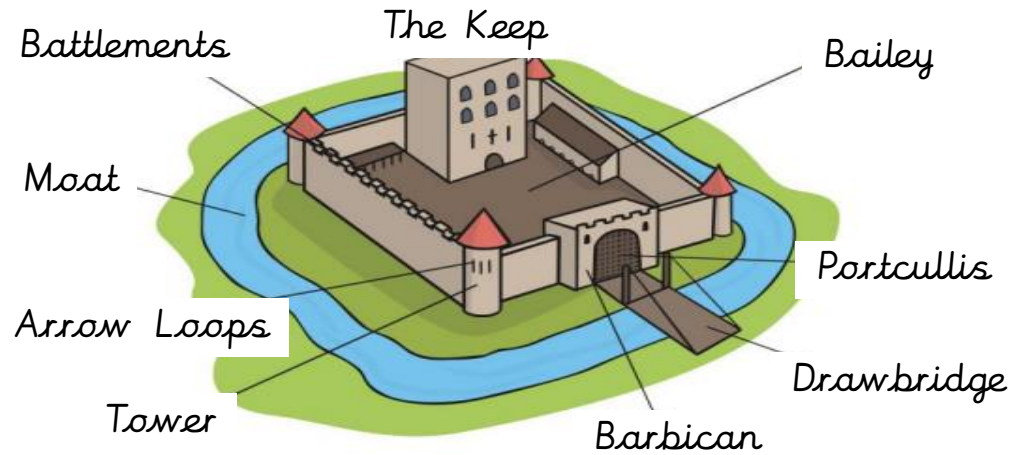
