Dear EYFS Parents and Carers,

We are very pleased with how the children are settling and they are doing a great job learning the routines and expectations of school. They have had so much to learn over the last 3 weeks and this has probably been quite tiring.

- Next week we begin full time so from 8:30-3pm each day for the majority of the children.
- If your child's PE kit is not yet in school, please bring it in as soon as possible as we would like to start changing next week.
- Lunches are going well and lots of children are trying new foods. After eating, the Reception children have started to join Key Stage 1 on the playgrounds for a playtime. You can see the menu on the website. Next week will be week 1 on the menu. You can look at this at home and talk to your child about what is for lunch. You might choose to send packed lunches some days and have dinners on other days. You do not need to tell us in advance and can chop and change as you like.
- As the weather is getting colder, please continue to teach children how to put on their coats and jumpers independently.
- Please continue to encourage children to wipe their bottoms independently.
